

Should The Hollywood Women's Club Have A Men's Group?

From time to time the Club has discussed forming a Men's Auxiliary/Booster Club/Group. It has always been defeated at the Board level and never gone to membership. In our discussions this year, we have also talked about a group of <u>men and women</u> who would be called the Friends of The Hollywood Women's Club. This time we are taking it to YOU! We want your input as we discuss the pros and cons!

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How many times have you cleaned up after a special event? How many times have you helped in the maintenance of the Clubhouse and the grounds? How many times have we done community projects that we could have used help? How often do we hear "I don't know anything about the Club?" How frequent do we raise funds with yeoman's work to set up and clean up? How often do we seek sponsors to no avail? How often do we hear "we could use help in many areas!"

GFWC Florida has had a Booster Club for many years. "Husbands, significant others, and all family members as well as friends and pets!"

Some believe that expanding our membership to non-voting, non-participants, who will not be invited to regular monthly meetings but will be invited to events and holiday special events would benefit the Club. They would be able to help out on community projects.

The Friends of the Hollywood Women's Club would be a group of committed and passionate individuals who support the Hollywood Women's Club and its mission: dedicating itself to community improvement by enhancing the lives of others through volunteer service. We are also dedicated to the preservation of our beloved historic 1927 Clubhouse.

The Friends of the Hollywood Women's Club would not join in club decisions, do not have voting privileges and are strictly a support group.

- Annual Dues are \$50.00
- They will not participate in monthly Day & Evening Group member meetings.
- They will be invited to 'special meetings', ie. Summer socials, holiday party.
- They will be able to participate in Community Service Projects.
- They will help in the maintenance of the Clubhouse.
- The group can elect their own Chairperson who will report to the Club President if they wish to.
- The group can hold one meeting a year.
- They will help expand community awareness and outreach of the Club

The Friends would enhance our present efforts including our fund raising results and help in expanding membership.

Many women do not want to fulfil the commitments of membership in the Club but they are certainly Friends!!!! This gives them another option to be part of the Club. For men, it allows those who join in our commitment to community and our Clubhouse but prevents them from asserting themselves running the Club. We will remain a Women's Club with special Friends.

Things seem perfect the way they are, why the need for a dramatic change?

There is a belief that male membership will "expand the revenue base," but why would there suddenly be an out-pouring of financial support from men who could help the club now if they wish to do so? "Annual dues of \$50.00" will hardly be a windfall for our treasury.

I believe that women come to a women's club because they want to socialize with women. If they wanted a mixed group they would go elsewhere. The entire climate and atmosphere changes when there is a mixed group. Changing the dynamics might be off-putting to current members. Women who enjoy an evening out without their husband/boyfriend/whatever may have something else to consider if confronted with the question, "Are there men there?"

At the current time we all know who the men are who would likely want to become members, they are fantastic people who are truly loved and would never be a problem to anyone. But if membership is made available to men, the door is opened to any man who wishes to join. Do we really want to do that? We usually know why women choose to join HWC, do we really want to start vetting what the motivation is for men who might apply for membership?

When this issue comes to a general membership vote, please be sure you've consider all aspects of your decision. It will affect our club, now and for many years to come.
