### CAMPAIGN TOMORROW 2017 - 2020

Thanks to the historic anonymous gift and receipt of a draft budget from our planning consultant, Charles Jordan, our goal has been increased to encompass a broader scope of work to include hurricane windows and restoring the front doors & sidelights besides funding handicap accessibility, building safety, electrical and lighting upgrades, and up- dating of the catering kitchen. Our anonymous donor's goal is to help us get the necessary renovations completed so we do not have to worry about them in the near future. The desired outcome is to improve accessibility and safety for Club Members, Guests and the Community.

A team of members (Issie Wise, Shelly deMarco, Dinah Pickett, Mardi Podesta, Carol Fitzgerald) is currently working on a grant proposal to Mary Porter Legacy Fund at the Community Foundation of Broward County for \$150,000 due October 9. Grant awards will be announced in December.

To date the Campaign has received a \$3,000 grant from the National Historic Preservation Trust for architectural expenses; \$2,000 from the Broward County Community Foundation and other gifts totaling \$1,495 which includes an inkind gift of service.

We have begun to develop prospect lists. A prospect is someone who has the willingness to donate and the ability to donate. Community leaders, former members, those interested in historic preservation or women's organizations; and the general public.
